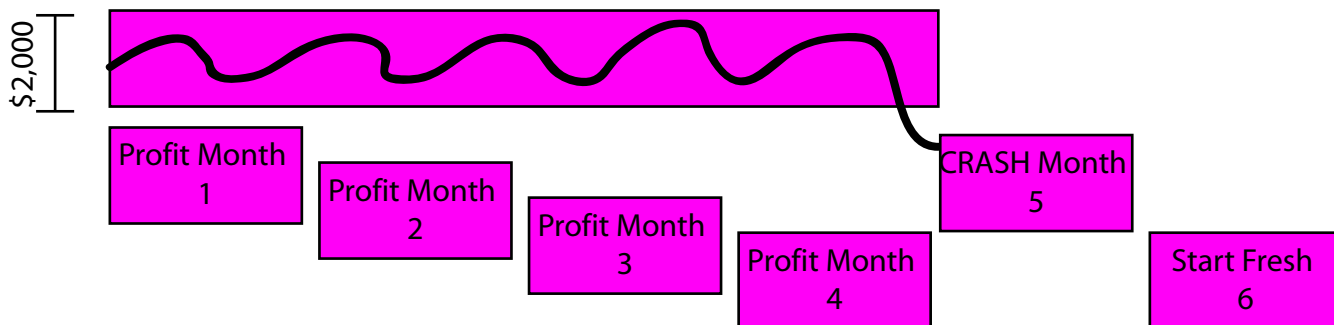


ONLY RISK WHAT YOU NEED TO WORK WITH.



FIND YOUR TRADING CHANNEL



Do not leave your profit sitting idle and at risk in the account.

On a Demo you need to find an acceptable channel of operating parameters that work consistently over a long period of time.

You start with Ten Thousand dollars in the Demo and you track the greatest amount of draw down on your equity and margin.

If your strategy gives you the results you require and stays inside of your trading boundaries, then there is no need to put at risk any additional money in the account.

If your final trading requirement is 20% or in this case \$2,000 then you only need two thousand to trade with. You want your strategy to stay well within the account balance. If there is an unsuspected or exaggerated move causing an excessive draw down in the account then you will get a margin call and the broker may close all of your trades at a loss.

Because you have only risked 20% of your account you still have \$8,000 to begin again with.

It would be important to have a strategy that doubles the amount you start with more frequently than the amount of margin calls per year. If you double the account three or more times than you get margined out then you may have a successful strategy.
